



QUILT SHOW RULES

BLACK HILLS QUILTERS GUILD

1. Registration may be completed via the website and paid by credit card or Paypal. Paper registration forms will also be accepted; mail to Black Hills Quilters Guild, Attn: QUILT SHOW Exhibit Coordinator, P.O. Box 2495, Rapid City, SD 57709
2. All quilts must have 3 layers (top, batting and back) and be clean and odor-free. Quilts without 3 layers will be "Exhibit only."
3. Quilts with false backs or frames will not be accepted in the judged category.
4. All quilts must have been made within the last 3 years and not previously entered in the Black Hills Quilters Guild Show.
5. BHQG reserves the right to reject quilts of an offensive nature.
6. BHQG reserves the right to place your quilt in a different category if it does not match the definition of the category or if there are less than 5 quilts in a category.
7. BHQG reserves the right to photograph quilts and display them on our website.
8. Entries may be offered for sale with the owner setting their price. Consignment fee is 10% for members and 20% for non-members.
9. A separate form must be used for each quilt entered.
10. Quilts may be entered in the Judged Category; \$10.00 for members and \$15.00 for non-members. Fee must accompany the registration form.
11. Deadline for registration is Tuesday, May 7, 2019. **No unregistered quilts will be accepted on June 5.**
12. Quilts must be delivered to the Rushmore Plaza Civic Center on **WEDNESDAY, June 5, between 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 noon.**
13. All quilts will be released at approximately **4:45 p.m. on SATURDAY, June 8.**

Definitions for Quilt Categories

Appliqued by hand or machine	Must be greater than 50% applique
Pieced by hand or machine	Must be greater than 50% pieced
Hand Quilted	Must be entirely hand quilted; may be appliqued or pieced
Unique Technique	Quilt must be predominately a special technique. Technique examples: whole cloth, yoyos, hand or machine embroidery, collage.
Miniature	Perimeter must be 120" or less with blocks 4-inches or less. <u>All</u> components must be miniature in scale.
Art	A creative expression by the quilter. The quilt and all components must be an original design created by the quilter (no patterns or copies of existing works). Items must be 3-layers and must be quilted.
Miscellaneous	Includes items that are dimensional or otherwise do not fit into the standard categories. Examples: pillows, garments, purses and tote bags, chairs, stuffed toys. Items must be 3-layers and must be quilted.
Special Exhibit	Quilts that are not judged. Includes quilts to be displayed in the Inspiration Studio, the Heart Quilts display, or other special exhibit.

Definitions for Types of Quilting

Professionally Machine Quilted	Quilted by someone who quilts for hire
Non-Professionally Machine Quilted	Quilted by someone who does not quilt for hire

UFO Contest

The UFO contest is open to BHQG Members Only. The quilt must have been started before August 1, 2018 and finished by May 7.
